Bottles Made From Plants – Not Oil

Our Ingeo™ Plant-based plastic bottles are not made from oil.

The manufacturing process primarily uses dextrose (sugar) from field corn, but the bottles can be made from any abundant sugar source including sugar beets, wheat, sugar cane, and more.

Even the Ingeo™ manufacturing process is greener than conventional plastic bottles.

Compared to traditional polymers like PET and polystyrene, the Ingeo™ process:

- Produces 60% less greenhouse gasses
- Uses 50% less non-renewable energy
